Language Arts

We enjoyed practicing different ways to read. The children are having fun reading digital books on EPIC, reading from their book bins, and reading to others. This week the children were introduced to a set of vocabulary words. We continued to discuss nouns and finding them in a sentence.

This week we began working on mental math and estimation. The children are working on adding and subtracting 2 digit numbers. They are using mental math and estimation strategies. You can always draw a number line and find the two benchmark numbers and a midpoint. We will continue to work on rounding.
