Hello Maple Point Families,

To ensure students are maximizing their time in class and present for announcements, we will focus on enforcing our late/tardy policies. We wanted to make all families aware of the policy.

The expectation is that students are in school before 8:00 am for homeroom and are ready to learn once first period begins. In order for a late arrival to be considered excused, a student must have a doctor's note or a note from a parent explaining why the student was late. Reasons such as traffic, oversleeping or missed bus are not excused lates.

LATE TO HOMEROOM/SCHOOL PROCEDURES

Late 1 and 2 – Student warning

Late 3 through 6 - Students are assigned to lunch detention.

Late 7- Students will be assigned two (2) detentions.

Late 8- and thereafter at the discretion of the appropriate grade-level administrator, students will be assigned an in-school suspension and/or an out of school suspension. A parent meeting with a truancy plan will be held.

NOTE: If a student is absent on the scheduled detention date, the student automatically will serve the next scheduled detention when they are in school. If the student does not attend an assigned detention and/or ISS, the student will receive an immediate Out-Of-School Suspension with a mandatory inschool parent conference. Also, the penalty for all future lateness to homeroom/school will be Out-of-School Suspension with an in-school parent conference.
