- 1. Claim-a proposed answer to a question about the natural world
- 2. Convert--to change from one type to another
- 3. Energy- the ability to make things move or change
- 4. Evidence-information about the natural world that is used to support or go against (refute) a claim
- 5. Generator- a machine that can convert kinetic energy into electrical energy
- 6. Kinetic energy-the energy that an object has because it is moving
- 7. Model- an object, diagram, or computer program that helps us understand something by making it simpler or easier to see
- 8. Potential energy-the energy that is stored in an object or system
- 9. Reasoning-the process of making clear how your evidence supports your claim
- 10. Scientific argument-a claim supported by evidence
- 11. System-a set of interacting parts forming a complex whole
- 12. Transfer-to move from one object to another or one place to another
