- Financial Update Treasurer, Beth Olmeda
 - Bank Account Status: We are digging in and reviewing our spending vs. profit. We are the only school that the PTO fully funds Field Trips, but with the cost of \$20K last year, we need to find ways to fundraise and make more money to keep Field Trips free of cost to the students. The PTO Bank Account currently sits at \$36K.

 - Dr. G. suggested maybe having student pay a marginal fee for Field Trips to help offset the cost.
