TITLE: AQUATICS

NESHAMINY SCHOOL DISTRICT

I. PROGRAM ORGANIZATION

- A. The natatoriums, constructed as part of the Middle Schools in the District, shall be considered an integral part of the physical education facilities of those buildings.
- B. The supervision of these facilities and the organization of the aquatics program shall be the responsibility of the Superintendent/Designee.
- C. The aquatic program in the District shall be considered to be a three phase program:
 1. Required aquatic education and adaptive program conducted during the regular school day.
 - a. This program shall be organized and planned cooperatively by the aquatic teachers (male and female) and the Physical Education Lead teacher with the Middle School Principals
 2. Extra curricular intramural and interscholastic program conducted from the close of the school day to 5:30 p.m.
 - a. The scheduling of the pools for this program shall be the responsibility of the appropriate designee named by the Superintendent.
 3. Community program conducted evenings, Saturdays and during vacation months.
 - a. The planning and development of this program shall be coordinated responsibility of the Community Aquatic Coordinator and any other designee(s) appointed by the Superintendent. (The Community Program shall be planned and developed as a self-supporting program.)
 - b. The Community Aquatic Coordinator shall be appointed by the Board upon being recommended by the District Superintendent.
