10	POLICY	The building principal authorizes the selection and use of parents/guardians,	10
11		community members, and others, as volunteers to assist and supplement	11
12		regular school district staff. The principal will provide a policy letter to each	12
13		volunteer and obtain an affirmation form to be completed by the volunteer.	13
14		Under no circumstances shall a volunteer be considered an employee of the	14
15		district. A volunteer shall receive no wages or other valuable consideration for	15
16		the performance of volunteer services. The volunteer position is not a right,	16
17		but a privilege that is conferred by the Board. Any such volunteer position	17
18		may be eliminated at any time for any reason or no reason.	18

I understand that the administrator, teacher, or supervisor who is employed by the District who is overseeing my volunteer activity is the decision maker, and I will respect his or her authority. When working with students, chaperoning a field trips or school activities, I will report to the person of authority all incidents of inappropriate behavior or any hazardous situations with I witness.

I understand that as a volunteer I will be viewed as a representative of the School Board and Administration. I will conduct myself in a professional manner and will maintain a professional relationship with students.

I agree to respect the privacy and anonymity of each child by maintaining the confidentiality of any information that I receive while serving as a volunteer.

I agree to report all incidents of suspected child abuse to the teacher or supervisor in charge of my volunteer activities.

I assume responsibility for being familiar with and following Board Policies and Administrative Procedures that are brought to my attention.

As a measure to ensure the safety of Neshaminy students and staff members, I understand that all volunteers who are not within visible and/or voice contact of another staff employee would be required to have clearances.

As a volunteer, I am required to receive tuberculosis screening if my volunteer work may involve ten or more hours per week in direct contact with children. I understand I must be documented free from tuberculosis before serving as a volunteer.

RE: VOLUNTEER POLICY

The Administration and Staff of the Neshaminy School District recognize that as a volunteer you make a valuable contribution to our educational program. We appreciate your support and commitment as a volunteer.

While acknowledging the tremendous support that you offer to students and staff, the School District recognizes that need to take steps to ensure the safety of each Neshaminy student. If you are individually responsible for the welfare of one or more children or have direct contact with children, you will need the following clearances: Pennsylvania and Federal criminal history check and Pennsylvania Child Abuse history clearance. If you have continuously maintained residency in this State for the last ten years, you are excused from obtaining a Federal criminal history check if you complete the District's sworn volunteer affirmation statement.

Applications for these clearances are available in the Human Resources office and on our website – <u>www.neshaminy.k12.pa.us</u>, Departments, Human Resources, Potential Employee Information. You are required to submit to a tuberculosis examination if your volunteer work may involve ten or more hours per week in direct contact with children. The cost of the examination will be at your own expense.

Please note that our Volunteer Policy is in no way a reflection on any individual and is not meant to question anyone's integrity or dedication to our students.

We look forward to your continuing service as a volunteer. Your involvement enriches the lives of our students in many different ways. Attached is a copy of the Neshaminy Volunteer Policy for your reference, as well as the volunteer affirmation form which requires your signature. The undersigned, being duly sworn according to law herein swears and/or affirms that I have been a continuous resident of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania for a period of at least ten (10) years prior to the date that I executed this Affidavit. Furthermore, I swear and/or affirm that I am not disqualified from serving as a volunteer for the Neshaminy School District pursuant to §6344(c) of the Pennsylvania Child Protective Services Law, in that I am not named in a statewide data base as the perpetrator of a founded report related to sexual misconduct at any time preceding the date of the execution of this Affidavit.

Furthermore, I hereby swear and/or affirm that I have not been convicted of one or more of the following offenses or an equivalent crime under federal law or the law of another State or the District of Columbia:

- 1. Chapter 25 (relating to criminal homicide).
- 2. Section 2702 (relating to aggravated assault).
- 3. Section 2709.1 (relating to stalking).
- 4. Section 2901 (relating to kidnapping).
- 5. Section 2902 (relating to unlawful restraint).

- 7. Section 3122.1 (relating to statutory sexual assault).

I understand that the execution of this Affidavit will only obviate the necessity of securing a federal criminal records check from the FBI and that there is still the requirement to secure a report of criminal history information from the Pennsylvania State Police, a certification from the Department of Public Human Services that the applicant is not named in the statewide database as the perpetrator of a founded report or an indicated report, and is not the subject of a pending child abuse investigation.

I verify that the facts and statements contained in this Volunteer Affidavit are true and correct to the best of my knowledge, information and belief. I understand that any false statements herein are made subject to the penalties of 18 Pa. C.S.A. Section 4903, relating to false swearing in official matters.
