21	(Extensions)	Board through the Superintendent's Office. Each case will be individually	21
22		reviewed and the name of the employee shall be kept confidential. In the	22
23		event the Board decides to extend the period of paid school leave, it shall	23
24		determine how long the payments shall continue to be made.	24
